

To be read attentively by campers and parents

In order to ensure a safe, harmonious, and respectful environment, it is important that all participants adhere to the following ethical code of behavior:

#### **ACTIVITIES:**

- All security rules must be respected whether on site or on an outing.
- All participants must remain with their assigned animator, at all times.
- Participation from each individual is required.

### TRANSPORT:

All security rules must be respected while travelling on the bus.

- All participants must remain seated while the bus is in movement and the aisle must be left cleared.
- 1 is strictly forbidden to smoke, eat or throw any objects outside of the bus.
- All passengers must remain calm throughout the bus ride to ensure a safe ride.
- Upon a complete stop, passengers must wait for the bus driver's signal to leave their seat, disembark from the bus and cross the street.

### FOOD:

- For security reasons (allergies and other), participants may not bring any food from home.
- Once the participant is finished eating, he/she must clean any mess that has been made. Participants must also be conscious of wasting any food.

### DORMS:

- Participants agree to not enter any room that is not their own.
- Participants respect the given curfew and avoid making any excessive noise that could disturb neighbouring rooms.
- Participants must ensure that both their room and bathroom is cleaned daily.

## **ENVIRONNEMENT:**

Our Nature Center is situated in a magnificent location, which we must treat with respect.

- Participants ensure the cleanliness of the site by using trashcans.
- Participants engage themselves by taking care of the premises and the material and equipment loaned to them. These rules are also applicable during outings.

# **MATERIAL**:

- The only personal items tolerated on site are those presented in the respective document. Jewellery, cellular phones and all other electronic devices are not accepted and the Nature Center is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- The participants must have all the necessary belongings for the length of their stay, and cannot borrow personal items from others.
- Using, possessing, or selling drugs, tobacco, alcohol or any offensive materials is strictly forbidden.

# **SOCIAL AFFAIRS:**

The participants adopt a positive and respectful verbal and non-verbal attitude towards others and staff members. In case of conflict, they agree to settle it peacefully by not posing any violent action that could hurt (touching, pushing, kicking, intimidating, etc.)
